# RULES GOVERNING THE INTERNAL CODE COMPETITION <dev\_Contest/>: show your incredible talent! ORGANIZERS BPCE SA CIO OFFICE GROUPE

AND ISOGRAD

## 1. ORGANIZATION

**BPCE**, a public limited company with a management board and supervisory board with share capital of €180,478,270, registered in the Paris Trade and Companies Register under number 493 455 042, whose registered office is located at 7 promenade Germaine Sablon, France, 75013 Paris,

hereinafter individually referred to as BPCE,

## AND

**ISOGRAD**, a simplified joint-stock company with share capital of €106,162.00, registered in the Paris Trade and Companies Register under number 525 280 616, is the registered office at 35, rue des Jeuneurs, 75002 PARIS in France,

Hereinafter referred to individually as "ISOGRAD",

Together called «the Organizers»,

Jointly organize the code contest called "Dev\_contest: show your incredible talent!" (Hereinafter the "Contest") under the conditions defined in these Contest rules (the "Rules").

The objective of the Contest is to promote employees and share a user-friendly moment within IT, create an emulation and community within developers, promote the development profession, promote the IT sector internally, promote externally the post event challenge for the employer brand.

The Code Contest will take place on Friday, March 24, 2023 in two phases:

- Dev\_Contest: show your incredible talent individual code contest duration 1h15 with 3 exercises of increasing difficulty easy - easy/intermediate - intermediate
- Dev\_Contest: show your incredible talent code contest by team of 3-4 employees grouped on the same site, lasting 1h30 with 3 exercises of increasing difficulty easy – intermediate - difficult

The code languages available during the competition on the ISOGRAD platform are:

For tests, ISOGRAD allows you to change languages during exercises of increasing difficulty. A Participant performing the individual contest can do the first exercise in Python and the second exercise in Cobol and the third exercise in PHP....

Participants in the team competition will also be able to change language during exercises of increasing difficulty.

The team competition will bring together 3 or 4 people from the same entity (see §2) to gather on the same site (usual professional site). When registering for the Competition, the employee must identify two or three employees with whom he or she would like to carry out the competition as a team. Employees on the same team will not necessarily have to be <u>familiar with the same programming language</u>. However, only one response to the exercises containing the lines of code should be sent to the editor. This single proposal will be the one corresponding to the response provided by the team.

In order to promote exchanges, share a friendly moment within the IT and create an emulation, it is required that the team consists of at least 3 employees with a maximum of 4 employees.

Any employee wishing to take part in the competition as a team who could not build a complete team can indicate this in the registration form so that the organizing team can try to build a complete team with other participants on the same site.

In order to promote collective emulation, the Organiser encourages employees to register for the individual and team competitions. However, participants may choose to participate only in the individual or team competition.

A competition opening ceremony will take place **on Thursday, March 23, 2023 (duration: 1 hour)** and a closing ceremony with awards will take place on Tuesday, **March 28, 2023 (duration: 1 hour)**. These ceremonies will be an opportunity to share a collective moment and to present the different entities, different collaborators from different locations in France and internationally participating in the contest.

# 2. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Participation in the Contest is free of charge and without obligation to purchase, subscribe or subscribe to contracts, products or services.

The Contest is exclusively open to persons who meet the following conditions: any employee employee (CDD, CDI, Alternant/intern\*) capable of coding, being part of one of the following IT entities/Divisions:

- DSI Corporate (BPCE SA or service center of Porto)
- CIO Office (BPCE SA or Porto Service Centre)
- TES (BPCE SA or Porto service centre),
- BPCÈ SI,
- BPCE IT,
- BRED and CASDEN autonomous SIs,
- Natixis CIB (GFS) and Natixis IM (GFS),
- Digital & Payments (Oney, BPCE Payment Services, Fintechs)

(\*) CDs, alternants/trainees wishing to enter the competition must be present in the Group at least until 30 March 2023,

Set hereinafter referred to as the "Participants"

External service providers, including temporary workers, may not participate in the competition.

#### 3. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Between 23/01/2023 at 07:00 and 06/02/2023 at 20:00 (Paris time) inclusive, to participate in the Contest, you must:

- (i) Be an employee of the Group mentioned in Article 2 of the Regulations,
- (ii) complete, in a complete and sincere manner, the participation form by filling in his surname, first name, name of the entity/management and building where the employee is used to carry out his activity, e-mail address
- (iii) complete and validate the registration form that will serve as the final registration.

The individual contest can be carried out on site or remotely. However, as this one takes place on the same day as the team competition, it is recommended to plan to be on site all day on Friday, March 24, 2023.

The team competition must take place in person on the sites of the different entities in order to promote sharing, the encounter of the other.

For the opening and closing ceremonies, employees are invited to join the amphitheatres reserved for the occasion by the various participating entities, to follow the ceremonies remotely or replay according to time zones.

All documents and information transmitted to the Organizer in connection with the Contest (hereinafter the "Documents"), as well as all copyright and other related proprietary rights, become the property of the Organizer upon transmission. The Participants agree to take any action (including, but not limited to, statements of honor) reasonably requested by the Organizer for the purpose of establishing, complete or confirm the Organizer's ownership of the Materials and any other related proprietary rights.

# 4. DESCRIPTION OF ALLOCATIONS AND DESIGNATION OF LAUREATES

The winner of the individual competition will be the employee who has completed the 3 exercises of increasing difficulty in the best time.

The winning team in the team competition will be the team that has completed the 3 increasing difficulty exercises in the

If no collaborator, no team completes all exercises in the allotted time, then ISOGRAD will designate the best developer or the best team of developers having the most advanced in the exercises.

The winner of the ALL ENTITIES PODIUM will be the participant who has completed the series of exercises of increasing difficulty in the shortest time. However, the winner of the ALL ENTITIES PODIUM will not be able to be part of the winners of the best developer PER ENTITY. He/she may, however, be included in the winners of the best team of developers PER ENTITY. This is so as not to penalise colleagues who are members of the same team.

In order to carry out these rankings, BPCE would like ISOGRAD to be able to communicate a single list containing all the participants registered for the competition (France and international) in order to proceed with the presentation of the awards.

#### 5. DELIVERY OF GRANTS

The Winners for the various awards will be nominated by ISOGRAD according to the rules specified in Article 4 above. The *awards* can only be awarded at the end of the last competition in the different countries.

ISOGRAD will provide BPCE with a list of the names of the various BPCE Laureates to be announced by BPCE at the closing ceremony. soient annoncés par BPCE, lors de la cérémonie de clôture.

If it appears after the Laureates' determination that there is doubt about the accuracy of the contact information provided by the Participants, BPCE reserves the right to request all supporting documents for the purpose of definitively validating the allocation of the allocations.

Winners will be informed at the closing ceremony that they have won an award. An e-mail will also be sent to them on the same day on their professional email entered in the registration form, if they were unable to attend the closing ceremony.

For international employees, the *awards* will be communicated via the communication relays of the organising entities (except for BRED and CASDEN where the relays are the IT directors).

The persons organizing the competition of the entity concerned, mainly BRED, Natixis CIB (GFS) and Natixis IM (GFS) will be in charge of making the necessary contacts to transmit the *awards* abroad if they appear.

# 6. CONTEST AMENDMENT OR CANCELLATION

BPCE reserves the right to modify, discontinue, cancel, postpone or suspend the Contest at any time and without notice without this decision giving rise to any claim or compensation. Any changes to the Rules made during the Contest will be announced by means of an amendment available by e-mail to each participant. Such changes shall be deemed accepted by the Participants.

# 7. DISQUALIFICATION

BPCE also reserves the right to exclude from participation in the Contest any person disturbing the conduct of the Contest (in particular in case of cheating or fraud. The use of *chatGPT* is also prohibited) or having failed to comply with the conditions of the rules and to revoke the Participant's right to obtain any award.

It is not the responsibility of ISOGRAD to verify that the use of chatGPT has taken place.

No claim relating to the Contest may be received after 30 calendar days from the closing of the Contest. The Organizers reserve the right to prosecute anyone who has defrauded or attempted to do so.

# 8. FORCE MAJEURE - LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The Organisers shall not be liable for any direct or indirect, material or intangible damage of any kind caused by (i) force majeure, circumstances beyond their control (fraud, attempted fraud, etc.) or any other circumstances that would require it, if the Contest were to be amended, suspended, extended, shortened or cancelled, (ii) the failure of any receiving equipment or lines of communication, (iii) the loss of any paper or electronic mail, and, more generally, loss of any data,

(iv) problems of routing, in particular of endowments, (v) a technical, hardware and software failure of any kind, including connection to the ISOGRAD platform, (vi) use or enjoyment of their endowment; any complaint in this regard must be addressed directly by the Laureate to the manufacturer of the concerned endowment, (vii) any strikes or legal or regulatory provisions not allowing the Laureates to fully benefit from their endowment.

#### 9. IMAGE RIGHTS

Subject to the agreement expressed in the Contest Entry Form, Entrants authorize the Organizers to use:

- within the framework of internal or external communication operations (limitation to the Organisers' website and to the LinkedIn social network) relating to the Contest and its promotion, without any consideration other than the award:
