

**Rules, terms and conditions of entry to the
“Challenge Missing Person Edhec Alumni” Competition 2017-2018
from 14 December 2017 to 11 February 2018**

Article 1: Competition Organiser

The association, EDHEC ALUMNI (hereinafter called the Organiser), whose head office is located at 24 Avenue Gustave Delory, 59057 ROUBAIX CEDEX 1, registered under the SIRET reference 354-065-732-00027, is organising a free competition (hereinafter called ‘the Competition’) from **14 December 2017 to 11 February 2018**, with no purchase obligation, and according to the terms and conditions set out in the present articles.

Article 2: Conditions of participation

The competition is open to members of EDHEC Alumni association

The Organiser reserves the right to undertake all verifications needed concerning the identity and the postal and/or e-mail address of the participants.

Personnel of EDHEC ALUMNI and its Partner company, including their family members and partners (whether spouses, civil law partners or unofficial partners), are excluded from taking part in the competition or from benefitting from any of the prizes, whether directly or indirectly.

Any person who does not provide their full identity and contact details or who sends inexact or incorrect details shall be disqualified, as shall any person who refuses to provide, or to register for use all subjective information concerning them that is strictly necessary for the administrative requirements of the competition.

Participation in the competition implies accepting the present rules, terms and conditions in full and without exception.

Failure to adhere to the competition rules, terms and conditions shall lead to the contest submission and the potential awarding of prizes being nullified.

Article 3: Rules, terms and conditions of participation

To take part in the competition, members of the alumni have to find alumni / students who have not updated their contact details in the Handbook (file created by EDHEC Alumni 05/12/2016). It is imperative to register to participate in the Challenge.

Article 4: The prizewinners and awarding of prizes

The first six winners of this Challenge will be people who complete the greatest number of valid addresses (a valid profile is: First Name and Family Name + Promo + Name of the company where she works and her country + function + 1 valid contact email (other than edhec.com)). Winners will receive:

First prize :	IPhone SE Apple 4G, 64 Go (666,26 € ttc)
Second prize:	Ipad mini 4, Wi Fi Tablette, processeur Apple A8 – 128 Go (491,84 € ttc)
Third prize:	Apple TV 4K – Gen 5 (220,73 € ttc)
Fourth prize:	Mini Drone Jumping Sumo Parrot Blanc (153,25 € ttc)

These gifts will not be combined with other promotions.

The winners will be notified after checking their eligibility for the prize in question.

The winners shall be notified by the Organiser by e-mail. Should a participant not respond after one month following the despatch of the e-mail, he or she shall be considered as having relinquished the prize, and the prize in question shall remain the property of the Organiser.

The winners must comply with the rules, terms and conditions. Should they fail to meet the criteria set out in the present rules, terms and conditions, they will not be eligible for the prizes. The participants authorise the Organiser to conduct all verifications necessary regarding their identity, their age, their postal address and the sincerity and honesty of their participation. To this end, the organiser reserves the right to request a copy of some form of identity from the prize-winner before sending the prize. Any false statement, identity or address shall lead to immediate disqualification and the refund of any prizes already sent.

Article 6: Awarding of prizes

The Organiser cannot be held responsible for sending a prize to an incorrect address if this is due to the negligence of the prize-winner. Any prizes that cannot be delivered to the person they are addressed to, for whatever reason, and through no fault of the Organiser (e.g. if the winner has moved without notifying the Organiser of his/her new address, etc.), shall remain the property of the Organiser.

Prizes cannot be exchanged with any other object or for money, and cannot be fully or partially refunded. The participants are hereby notified that the sale or exchange of all prizes is strictly forbidden.

Article 7: Case of force majeure – extension to the duration of the competition

The Organiser's liability shall not be engaged if, on account of an event, an obligation or for any other reason outside its control, the competition must be altered, shortened or cancelled. The Organiser reserves the right in all circumstances to extend the period of participation and any previously announced deadline.

Any changes to the present rules shall be submitted to the “Michel Jacq 11 bis rue Thiers 29392 Quimperlé” in France and will come into force as soon as they are published online. By participating in the competition, participants shall be considered to have agreed to potential new competition rules, terms and conditions from the moment they come into force. Any participant who refuses to adhere to the new rules, terms or conditions shall be considered as having withdrawn from the competition.

Article 8: Registration of the rules, terms and conditions

The regulation is available free of charge to anyone who so requests to the organizer of the Game

Stamps related to the written request of a copy of the settlement will be paid at the ordinary rate on request.

Article 9: Personal data

You are hereby reminded that entrants who take part in the competition must supply a certain amount of personal information (name, address ...). This information is recorded and saved in an electronic file and is essential for the eligibility of their entry, the determination of the winner and the attribution and routing of the prizes. This information is required by the Organiser, and may be transmitted to its technical service providers and to a service provider handling the distribution of prizes.

In accordance with act n° 78-17 of 6 January 1978 relative to the freedom of information, contestants have the right to access, alter and delete any information that concerns them. To exercise these rights, entrants must send a letter to the competition Organiser.

Article 13: Disputes

The present rules, terms and conditions are subject to French law.

Any complaints relative to the competition must be addressed in writing to the competition Organiser and shall then be carefully examined.

Any claims must be made within ninety (90) days following the deadline of participation in the competition in accordance with the present rules, terms and conditions.

In the event of continued disagreement with the application or the interpretation of the present rules, terms and conditions, and failing a friendly settlement between the parties, the dispute shall be referred to the competent court in Paris that shall have full jurisdiction in the matter.
